DAYTIME PAVING OPERATIONS AND INTERMITTENT LANE CLOSURES SCHEDULED NEXT WEEK ON INTERSTATE 5 IN FRESNO COUNTY

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces intermittent lane closures scheduled for next week on Interstate 5 in Fresno County. Maintenance crews will be performing paving operations throughout the affected areas.

The following closures will be in effect, weather permitting:

- On Tuesday, May 24 from 7 a.m. until 2 p.m., northbound Interstate 5 will be reduced to one-lane intermittently from Lassen Avenue to the Coalinga Avenal Rest Area, a distance of 1.1 miles.
- On Wednesday, May 25 from 7 a.m. until 2 p.m., southbound Interstate 5 will be reduced to one-lane intermittently, beginning at the Jayne Avenue overcrossing for a distance of one-mile.

Caltrans Maintenance workers remind you to drive with extra care and allow additional travel time while travelling in the maintenance area. Please be alert for Road Maintenance Personnel and “Slow for the Cone Zone.”
