## TRAFFIC CONTROL RESUMES OCTOBER 10-14 ON STATE ROUTE 168 NEAR SHAVER LAKE

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces that two traffic control measures will resume next week on State Route 168 near Shaver Lake as part of an ongoing tree removal project.

**The following one-way traffic control will be in effect, weather permitting:**

- One-way traffic control will be in effect on State Route 168 north of Shaver Lake beginning Monday, October 10 through Friday, October 14 from 7:00 a.m. until 5:30 p.m. each day. Traffic delays are expected to last up to 15-minutes.
- On State Route 168 south of Shaver Lake, one of two lanes in each direction will be closed beginning Monday, October 10 through Friday, October 14 from 7:00 a.m. until 5:30 p.m. each day. Traffic delays are expected to be less than five minutes.

**Closures may continue for longer periods of time each day if necessary, due to delays caused by weather or uncontrollable events that may occur during tree removal operations. These scheduled closures will occur, weather permitting.**

**Commuters are reminded to obey flagging personnel and pay close attention to maintenance vehicles and personnel at all times.**
