NORTHBOUND STATE ROUTE 99 RAMP CLOSURES THIS WEEK IN TULARE COUNTY

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces temporary on-ramp and off-ramp closures on Northbound State Route 99 this week in Tulare County for roadway excavation.

The following on-ramp and off-ramp closures will be in effect, weather permitting:

- The northbound State Route 99 on-ramp from Avenue 368 will be closed **Wednesday, July 27 from 6:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.**
- The northbound State Route 99 off-ramp to Dodge Avenue will be closed **Thursday, July 28 and Friday, July 29 from 6:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. each night.** This exit also serves the CH Warlow Rest Area. Motorists will need to access the rest area via an alternate route during work hours.

Closures may continue for longer periods of time each day if necessary, due to delays caused by weather or uncontrollable events that may occur during maintenance. These scheduled closures will occur, weather permitting.

Reckless or inattentive drivers traveling through Work Zone Areas have caused the majority of Work Zone Deaths. Caltrans wants to remind drivers to stay attentive and undistracted while driving and to be cognizant of workers and vehicles in Construction and Maintenance Areas and slow down while driving through Work Zones.
