

Project Purpose:

The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate the roadway, widen shoulders and widen intersections in order to improve safety and operations.

Project Description:

The project is on State Route 190 near Tipton from west of Road 184 to Road 236. The project proposes to overlay the roadway with asphalt concrete, realign the centerline, and widen shoulders. Widening will be done symmetrically to avoid impacts to homes. In addition, sidewalk will be constructed and the current drainage system will be improved.

Construction Cost: \$6.4 Million

Begin Construction: June 2008

End Construction: Spring 2009

Funding Sources: State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP)-Roadway Rehabilitation Program
